Sprouts – Parent-Infant Program

This program is designed for infants accompanied by a guardian 5 months through 18 months of age. Each group meets one morning per week (Fridays) from 9:30 to 11:00 a.m. for a total of 18 mornings (9 weeks). The cost is \$220 for 18 mornings. This cost covers both parent and child. A \$50 nonrefundable deposit must accompany your application to reserve a place in the class.

Sweet Peas – Parent-Child Program

This program is designed for children accompanied by a guardian from 19 months to 3 years old. Each group meets two mornings per week (either Monday & Wednesday or Tuesday & Thursday) from 9 – 11 a.m. for a total of 18 mornings (9 weeks). The cost is \$380 for 18 mornings. This cost covers both parent and child. A \$50 nonrefundable deposit must accompany your application to reserve a place in the class.
